- ❖ The **abundant life** referred to in John 10:10 is _____ life with God the Father and with Jesus, His Son. (John 10:10; Romans 8:32; 2 Corinthians 9:15; Revelations 21:3-4)
 - **Dead Horse** – Inconsistent *contemplation of* and sometimes *indifference towards* abundant life.
 - **Change** – A more persistent and calculated *reflection on* abundant life.

- ❖ Having **knowledge of** and being **obedient to** the _____ of Jesus (*the truth of the word of Jesus*) will bring about freedom in our lives from slavery to _____. (John 8:31-36; Romans 6:5-7)
 - **Dead Horse** – Inconsistency to live in *freedom from* slavery to sin.
 - **Change** – Live *knowing, claiming, and acting out on* the truth of Jesus which brings about freedom from slavery to sin.
